Please allow me to start off the New Year by thanking you for all the donations and blessings given this past year! We truly appreciate your support in our mission to serve Veterans providing them the best care and services around! I believe we have the best staff and would put them up against any staff from any other Home. I tell everyone that we are certainly not perfect; however we have such a wonderful group of people that goes above and beyond on a daily basis. So again, thank you for your continued support!

With the New Year, we have several goals which we are working hard to achieve. Our first goal is to have a deficiency free survey. We are surveyed annually by an organization contracted by the Veterans Administration who completes a survey similar to surveys conducting in the private sector. Our team is working diligently to ensure we have effective systems and processes in place as our survey will be coming up towards the first part of April. The surveyors are required to speak with family members as part of their process and they appreciate hearing positive comments as well as any concerns you may have. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding this process.

Our second goal is to work with our Assistance League in raising enough donations to purchase a new bus. We have raised approximately \$35,000 the past couple years but need to raise a total of \$110,000.00. The bus will carry up to 14 Veterans on recreational outings to events such as KC Royals games, the American Royal, Sprint Center concerts and Monster Truck competitions, area museums, KC Chiefs training camp, St. Joe Mustang games, restaurants, movies, shopping, and Cameron H.S. football games just to mention a few. As you can imagine, these outings are so very important to the Veterans and truly impacts their quality of life at the Veterans' Home. Please be generous and consider a donation to the bus campaign and remember the men and women this will benefit served our country with pride and honor. Please pass on this message to anyone who will want to make a contribution benefiting those who have served.

Our final goal is to continue to strive to be the best we can be which will ensure that we are providing the best care and services to the Veterans' of the Home. 

