Arnold L. Theobald



The "St. Louis Veterans Home Committee" was formed in the spring of 1983 with two primary goals. They are to express the need of a state operated veterans home in the St. Louis Metropolitan area and to serve as it's Assistance League. In the begin-

ning, support was thin, with many groups and organizations believing there goal/objectives would not be reached. Research was conducted to determine site requirements. You had to be close to the utilities but far away from noise and other negatives.

The ideal site would be need to be at least 15 acres, but much more would be preferred. At that time, good acreage was running about \$33,000 an acre and the state would like the land to be donated as it was in all other home locations.

One of the first sites looked at was the Robert Koch (TB) Hospital located in South County across Highway 270 from Jefferson Barracks V.A. Hospital. These were old buildings, built like a fort and would cost more to fix then to build new. Plus the property belonged to the City of St. Louis and they were asking \$6.5 million. Over the next several years numerous other sites were looked at, most being old abandon schools. Most of them had something in common: closed, needed major repair, asbestos, and they were all asking 1.5 million dollars even though they were from different school districts.

One good possibility for a location was St. Mary's on the Mount Hospital on South Broadway just inside the St. Louis County for the City Limits. State Senator Irene Trippler and State Representative Joseph Treadway lead the way to have the bill for \$1,750,000 passed by the House and Senate. It provided \$1.5 million to buy the property and a quarter million for maintenance until federal funds were available to build. With the wisdom, then Governor Ashcroft vetoed the bill and on the day of the veto he pledge to meet with members of the St. Louis Veterans' Home Committee on alternatives. Within a month that meeting was held. Governor Ashcroft expressed his concern about aging Missouri veterans and acknowledged that there was a need in the St. Louis Metropolitan area. He promised to give his support if the proper location could be found.

Less then a month after that meeting with the governor, Mr. Francis St. John, a past State Commander for the V.F.W. and former member of the State Veterans Affairs Committee suggested that we look at the state land just south of Highway 270 on Lewis and Clark Blvd. With the assistance of Mr. Gregory Haden of Luxenburg Realty Company of South County, and two architects, viewed the location and recommendations were made. With those recommendations a meeting was held with Mr Richard "Dick" Rice then the Director of Public Safety for the State of

Missouri and members of his and Governor Ashcroft's staff. Within a week after that meeting members of the Department of Public Safety, the Governor's Office, Missouri Veterans Commission and Design and Construction flew by helicopter to the suggested site location. After a short period of time it was learned that the site was approved but was being planned for the west side of Highway 367 just south of Highway 270. It was that group that put together the legislative package for the Veteran's Home in St. Louis. Just prior to construction the site was changed to its present location on the east side of Highway 367.

With all of the hard work that the St. Louis Veteran's Home Committee put into this project, and the fund raising activity for the home, Robert R. Buckner, then the Superintendent of the Missouri Veterans Homes recognized the St. Louis Veterans' Home Committee as the Missouri Veterans Home—St. Louis Assistance League on April 25, 1990, long before construction was started.

The groundbreaking ceremony was on May 24, 1991 and The Missouri Veterans Home—St. Louis accepted its first residence in October 31, 1993 and has been serving those who served ever since.

With the support of many individuals groups and organizations, we have been able to improve the livelihood of the men and women who brought us the freedom we enjoy every day.

It's these individuals and organization that are very important. We can not thank you enough for your financial support.

The long range future of the Veterans Home Committee is the Perpetual Trust Fund. This endowment fund is set aside and only the interest is used. The primary need for this is, as our Veterans pass away, so does a lot of support that we have been receiving from them and their organizations. Approximately every two minutes a memory of wars, sights and sounds, its terrors and triumphs, disappear. Yielding to the inalterable process of aging, the men and women who fought and won these great conflicts are now aging. Veterans are dying at a rate of approximately 550 a day, according to recent US Veterans Administration figures. We need to build this fund to maintain the financial support for the home and future Veterans.

There are several ways that we receive money for the trust fund: A simple donation of \$10.00 for a Honorary Membership. That is placed into the trust fund and the individual will receive a publication about the home every three months. A direct donation to the fund in any amount. For a donation of \$1000 that individual or organization will have a single room dedicated to them, and for \$2000 a double room. For \$5000 a plaque will be placed on a living room wall. One of the largest forms of donations comes from memorials. All memorials are placed into the Perpetual Trust Fund, a tax receipt is issued, and a sympathy card is mailed to the deceased family, letting them know that your donation was made in the name of the loved one. The most important donation that a person can make is to the Trust Fund. It is the Trust Fund that will be providing a large part of assistance to those Veterans, who have yet to come and will need our services.
