Dewey Riehn, Legislative Chair VFW, informed Commissioners the Governor has embraced a plan to raise casino fees to generate more money for nursing homes for military veterans and asked the Commission to take an official position. After much discussion Member Callahan made a motion that MVC officially supports the \$1 increase in gaming admission fees. Senator Pearce seconded the motion. By a voice vote the motion passed unanimously. Chairman Comerford and Larry Kay will inform the Governor's office of this action.
